Problem Definition: In 1958, Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. led the March on Washington. At the march, he gave a speech about a dream he had. His dream was that all people should be judged not on how they looked or where they came from but on their actions and accomplishments. Dr. King had always believed that all people deserved to be treated equally. He believed that all people deserved respect. Therefore, Dr. King worked hard to gain equal rights for everyone and in a nonviolent way. He led marches, protests, and boycotts. He gave speeches and wrote articles. Many people joined him in this work for equal rights.

More than fifty years have passed since Dr. King shared his dream. According to U.S. laws, people now have equal rights. The laws state that people should not judge others by their race, religion, or background. We should have respect for all people.
